BACKGROUND


Polish migrants in the UK:

- Nr 1 country of foreign citizens
- Nr 2 country of foreign-born
- Nr 2 most spoken language

Census 2011 for England and Wales, National Office for Statistics

East-West Migration & EU-Enlargement:

- context of the history of Polish migration to the UK
- EU-Enlargement freedom of movement
- privatised migration regime shaped by market forces and migrants' agency (Ciupijus 2011)
